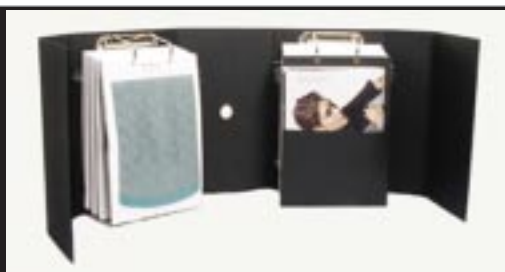


Stoll offers new Pattern Library service
